Main Boatyard and West Yard

Safety Protocols and Procedures

updated as of October 30, 2020

As the 2020 boating season concludes and boats are being placed “on the hard,” please note the following updates to SCYC’s safety protocols as it relates to boat storage areas in the main boatyard and west yard. Note that notwithstanding the updates below, visitors to the yard are still expected to maintain social distancing, wear masks, and maintain proper hygiene by washing hands and/or the use of hand sanitizers.

- The main and west yards will be open to all boat owners. Boat owners will be required to wear masks and stay on or close to their boats. Please maintain social distance of 6 feet and wear a mask when interacting with other boat owners in the yard.
- If Boatyard personnel are working on stored boats on weekdays or weekends, members, boat-owners and guests must comply with the social distancing protocols set forth above with respect to such boatyard personnel.
- Contact or conversation with Boatyard personnel should be avoided. Boatowners should also avoid being on the boat at the same time as boatyard personnel. Boatyard crew will not work below with the owner or guest onboard.
- Restrooms in the yard will be locked and are off limits to boat owners and members.

The Club reserves the right to refuse to allow anyone to attend to their boats who does not follow the safety protocols or does not have the proper safety items with them at the time of their visit.
